- 1 **Comte de la Boisserie, Sauvignon, Loire, 2014, France** An excellent crisp dry white wine, from the Loire region.

- 2 **Alfredini Pinot Grigio / Gargenega, 2014, Veneto, Italy** Light in colour, refreshing, and crisp with aromas of limes, grapefruits & lemons making this well balanced wine very easy to drink.

- 3 **Five Foot Track, Chardonnay, 2013, South Eastern Australia** Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits & ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon & lime on the palate, served with a rounded buttery feel.

- 7 **Le Bois des Violettes Rose, 2011, Carcassonne, France** Aromas & flavours of delicious berry fruits ripened under the hot summer sun

- 10 **Moulin de Laval, Merlot, Languedoc-Roussillon, 2014, France** Deep, plummy pure Merlot from a vineyard near Nîmes in southern France

- 11 **Aires Andinos, Malbec 2014, Mendoza, Argentina** Deep violet in colour, the wine exudes smooth black fruit on the palate with warming hints of spice on the finish

- 12 **Five Foot Track, Shiraz, 2013, South Eastern Australia** A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit & savoury, earthy tones on the nose. The palate is succulent & mouth-filling, with lashings of red berries & brambles.

- 13 **Torre Aldea Tinto Rioja, 2013, Rioja, Spain**
